Only fish 30 cm or longer can be registered for the event.</p> <p>The organiser or any person acting as an official during the competition may; inspect registered competitors' rods, reels, bait and fishing lines, instruct any competitor to conform to any or all the rules described herein, and direct that competitors surrender their identification card.</p> <p>All angling will be in the Wimmera River which the given area of the official map location online, horshamfishingcomp.com.au</p> <p>No photos will be received after 3:10 PM on the day of the competition, without previous approval.</p> <p>Fish eligible for a prize must be landed by the registered angler, on their own fishing rod. Anglers entered in the junior competition may have helped land a fish but must be present and involved.</p> <p>Annual Horsham Fishing Competition Inc. Official Rules 2022 Only those who have both paid to participate in the 2022 Annual Horsham Fishing Competition, are over eighteen (18) years AND are a licensed fisherman may bring and consume alcohol at the competition. Any person breaching this rule will be removed from the area and may be fined by Horsham Council Officers or Victoria Police. The competition is operating under the current COVID guidelines as applicable to the State of Victoria.</p> <p>The competitor's entry in the competition is deemed to signify acceptance of all conditions and rules of this contest.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● The Fishing Contest shall be conducted on Sunday, March 13, 2022. ● All prizes are non-transferable and non-refundable. ● People aged up to 15 on the day of the competition are eligible for the junior section. If they pay for a senior entry they can fish for the senior section prizes only. ● Only fish caught in the areas designated on the official map, as can be found on the website, can be submitted for registration. ● Fish measurements will be to the complete centimeter (e.g. if a fish measures 43.6cm, it will be recorded as 43cm) ● Prizes not collected within 30 business days of the close of the contest will be deemed to be forfeited ● It is clearly understood that the entry is accepted on the condition that any person or persons participating in the contest do so at their own sole risk and any such person shall NOT claim against the, ACE Radio Network, Horsham Fishing Competition Inc. (the committee) or any official or servant or other persons appointed by or acting on behalf of the said organisers or in connection with the contest for any injuries or loss suffered by himself or herself or any other person to by any act omission or negligence on the part

of the committee or any other sponsors or official servants as aforesaid.

- Every entrant taking part in the contest shall indemnify the said Committee or other sponsors and the official servants and the other persons aforesaid against the claim by any other entrant or person whatsoever or howsoever arising.

 - Each contestant must practice social distance with a gap of at least 2 meters to any other contestant who is not a member of the same household.
 - Roping of the river is not permitted.
 - There are no official stakes. Angling spots are first in best dressed and are only considered "taken" where another angler is currently fishing from the spot. You must allow 2.5 metres from the nearest angler to allow room for everyone to fish comfortably and safely.
 - You can move fishing spots as long as it is within the designated fishing area according to the official online map.

- Unruly behaviour, including bad language or threatening towards any ACE Radio Representatives or Horsham Fishing Competition committee member or volunteer will not be tolerated. This behaviour may incur immediate disqualification from the Horsham Fishing Competition at the discretion of the President or committee member.

Measuring and Verification Procedure

Prize Winning Fish will be based on length & not weight.

Prizes will be available for the three (3) longest fish in each of the following 3 categories (Yellowbelly, Catfish & Silver Perch or Redfin-) and also as random draws.

You will need either a digital Camera or Mobile Phone

'Catch, Photograph & Release' of all legal sized eligible fish (Yellowbelly, Silver Perch, Catfish, Redfin and Carp). You will be required to photograph your fish, nose to zero end and stomach facing the photographer on a clearly readable measuring device, brag mat, ruler or the like. Photographs must clearly include your Horsham Fishing Competition registration card and competitor ID number and visibly show the fish nose on the zero end and where the fish tail finishes. Once the photo has been taken, all fish must be released alive and in a healthy condition ASAP other than carp, which should be taken to a collecting point for correct disposal. Photos must be presented (in person or via text, preferred, confirming name & entrant number) during the competition hours (6.30am to 3pm). Distorted, undistinguishable, unreadable and blurry photos will not be accepted.

If your fish has the potential to be one of the Top 3 lengths in each category you will be required to bring your phone/camera to the Admin Office at Competition Headquarters - Horsham Angling Club for verification. You will be contacted by a Committee member

to arrange this. Committee will be posting live updates with Angler Identification numbers confirming the current leader board.

In the event of a tie, the earliest captured fish of the same length/species will be declared.

CATCH, PHOTOGRAPH, RELEASE INSTRUCTIONS

1. Catch your fish (Any of the 4 nominated Species over 30cm). All fish less than 30cm to be returned to the river ASAP and are not eligible.
2. Place fish on an official brag sticker, nose to zero end, stomach facing photographer.
3. Place Angler Identification card on or near fish so it is visible in the photo
4. Take a clear photograph from above capturing nose, tail, measurement and ID all in one.
5. Release your Fish.
6. Send your Photo for Verification during the competition hours (Sunday 6.30am – 3pm). If you cannot submit your photograph before 3.10pm, please call or text headquarters so we are aware of your entry.
7. The committee will contact anglers who need to present their phone/camera for verification. The contact will be made to the mobile number against the angler identification number at the time of registration.

Horsham Fishing Competition registration card and competitor ID number.

As part of your registration process you will be required to collect in person your Horsham Fishing Competition Registration Card which includes your Competitor ID Number. This will be available to collect on Friday 11th March between 3pm & 7pm and Saturday between 8am & 5pm at the Competition Headquarters - Horsham Angling Club.

Fishing Regulations

- The event will target Golden Perch / Yellowbelly, Silver Perch, Catfish, Redfin and European Carp. No other species can be registered.
- The event will be Catch & Release, other than for European Carp which will be collected and disposed of.
- Only fish 30cm or longer can be registered.
- No European Carp can be returned to the river, all are to be taken to collection points for disposal.
- The organiser, or any person acting as an official at any time during the competition may:
 - Inspect registered competitors rods, reels, bait and fishing lines.
 - Instruct any competitor to conform to any or all the rules described herein.
 - Direct that competitors surrender their identification card.
- All Angling will be in the Wimmera River at Horsham between the Horsham Weir and the Riverside bridge as per the official map.
- All angling shall be from the river bank.
- The times of angling shall be between 6.30 am and 3.00 pm local Horsham time. Competitors must not fish prior to the start time on the day of the competition; failure to adhere to this will result in disqualification.
- No photos received after 3.10pm can be registered, without previous approval.

- Fishing from bridges, boats or craft is strictly prohibited. Fishing is prohibited on all islands, with the exception of Adventure Island.
- Fishing is permitted from the fishing pontoons, however please make sure pontoons are available to anglers with a disability.
- An effort must be made to cast lines towards the middle of the river so as not to cross lines with other contestants.
- Each competitor is allowed to use TWO (2) rods, with a maximum of TWO (2) hooks per rod. Spinners count as TWO (2) hooks.
- Each competitor will be given an Angler Identification Card (AIC) with a unique number. This is to be shown clearly in any photos of fish for registration.
- Fish eligible for a prize MUST BE LANDED by the registered angler, on their own fishing rod.
- Anglers with a disability or injury that means they are unable to land a fish independently can have help, however they must be present and as involved in landing the fish as they are able.
- Anglers entered in the junior competition may have helped landing a fish but must be present and involved.
- See above for instructions on measuring landed fish and verification procedures.
- The chief referee may disqualify any fish for reasons such as: fish not legal as per Victorian fishing regulations; was not landed by the angler who holds the rod tag; was tethered or imported from another waterway.
- If an angler is disqualified for breaching of the rules, the entrance fee will not be refunded.
- Protests must be lodged personally to the referee table no later than 3.30pm, local Horsham time, on the day of the competition.
- To avoid gatherings, the presentation will be done live via Facebook as soon as practicable, after the conclusion of the competition.
- A Victorian Recreational Fishing License is required, by law, for all Anglers aged 18 or over, except where specific exemptions apply.
- If two (or more) eligible fish are of the same weight, the fish weighed earliest, as per weigh-in book, will be eligible for the prize, or higher ranked prize.

Fishing Section and Lucky Entrant Prizes

- Prizes will be awarded to 1st, 2nd and 3rd longest of each of the following three (3) categories caught by a senior entrant: Catfish, Golden Perch / Yellowbelly, and Redfin or Silver Perch.
- Prizes will be awarded to the 1 st, 2nd, and 3rd of each of the following three (3) categories caught by a junior entrant: Catfish, Golden Perch / Yellowbelly, and Redfin or Silver Perch.
- Prizes will be awarded the 5 longest Carp caught by a senior entrant.
- Prizes will be awarded for the 2 longest Carp caught by a junior entrant.
- 3 Senior bag prizes will be awarded, they will be determined by cumulative length of five longest carp caught by each senior angler.
- There will be a random prize draw for all senior entries who catch and release Yellowbelly, Catfish, Silver Perch or Redfin.
- There will be a random prize draw for all junior entries who catch and release a Yellowbelly, Catfish, Silver Perch or Redfin.

- There will be a random lucky entry prize draw for all senior entries.
- There will be a random lucky entry prize draw for all junior entries.
- All randomly drawn prizes will be drawn in descending order of value as per prize list which will be available before the competition.
- No photos will be received after 3:10 PM on the day of the competition, without previous approval.

Camping Regulations

- All Signs must be observed.
- Failure to comply with signs, or co-operate with fishing competition officials may render contestants liable to disqualification, without refund of entry fee.
- No camping is permitted within 20 metres of the river's edge, or between fenced revegetation areas and the river.
- An up-to-date plan of camping areas will be available from the headquarters. Please note, there may be changes from last year.
- All noise, including music, is to be kept at a minimum between 9.30pm and 6am. Event organisers reserve the right to ask campers to leave the river if noise rules are not adhered to. Anyone removed from the river bank will also be disqualified from the competition.
- Some areas have restrictions on camping. Please observe signs on the river bank.
- Swimming is NOT permitted within the defined fishing competition area between midnight on the Saturday prior to the competition, until 4pm on the day of the competition.
- NOTE the fishing competition is conducted on farming land, private land and public parks. Please respect these areas - our use of these areas is a PRIVILEGE, not a right.
- Garbage containers are supplied. All rubbish is to be placed in them.
- All camp fires must adhere to Country Fire Authority regulations. They must be attended at all times and FULLY EXTINGUISHED before being left. If you are not prepared to walk barefoot over them do not leave them.
- Any competitor found fishing before 6.30am, local Horsham time, on the day of the competition shall be disqualified.
